Local man opens kiosk at Tyrone Mall

ST. PETERSBURG – Tyrone Center Mall has just become a little more convenient for shoppers and mall employees with the opening of the Street Corner kiosk that sells items such as cough drops, aspirin and chips.

Franchise owner Vincent Bruno of Pinellas Park opened the kiosk after a 28-year career in the restaurant industry.

“People can pull over while driving at any number of places to get the snacks and necessities they need as they go about their daily routines, but for some reason, that same convenience was lacking at the mall,” said Bruno.

The Street Corner chain is based in Topeka, Kan., and has stores and kiosks in 19 states. This is the chain’s third location in Florida, and the first in the Tampa Bay area.

In addition to chips, candy and bottled drinks, the Tyrone Center Street Corner sells a variety of sundry items and over-the-counter remedies, coffee, cigarettes, cigars, lottery tickets and drinks.
